## First Steps

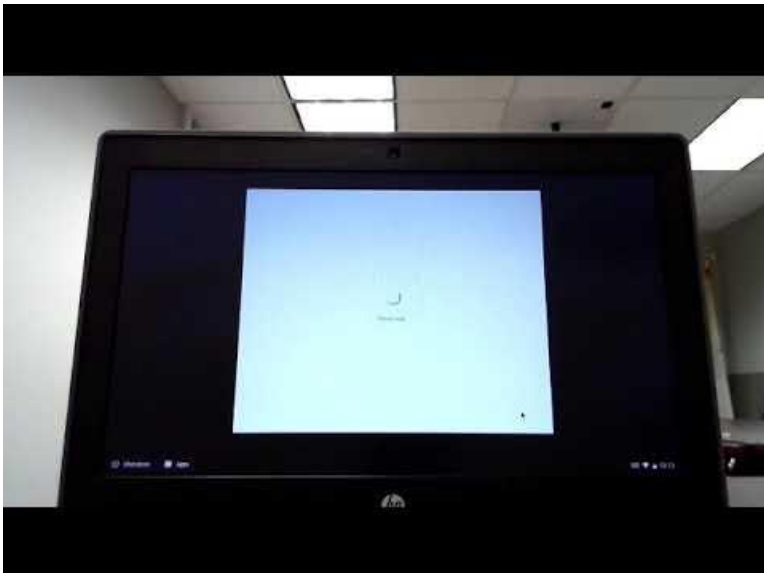
Log in to your child's chromebook:

- Students in K-1 will use Clever Badges (QR Code) to log in.
- Students in 2-12 will use their school email and password to log in.

### What is Google Classroom?

- Google Classroom is your child's digital link to remote learning.
- When logged in, students can collaborate with peers and teachers.
- Google Classroom is a safe digital space where students can view announcements, class content, assignments, assessments, and homework. Students will be able to turn work in through Google Classroom.

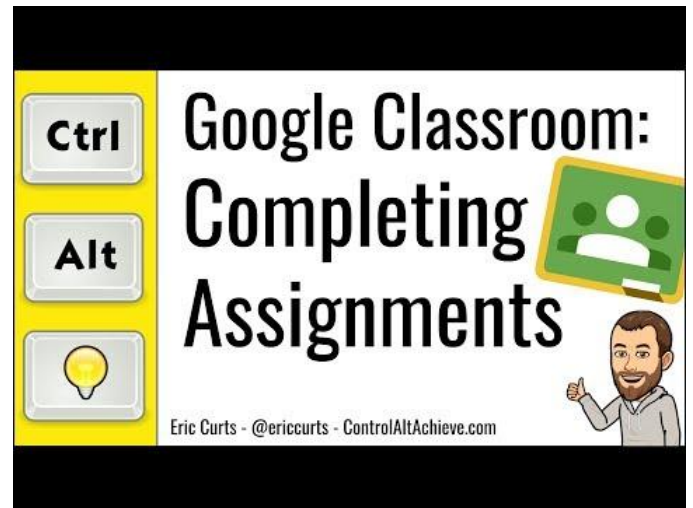
