

*DISTRICT PROCEDURES FOR WINTER WEATHER CONDITIONS
2017-2018*

Weather conditions can change rapidly in the winter months. When weather is potentially threatening, Alton administrators constantly monitor forecasts and the condition of roads, parking lots and sidewalks.

With this in mind, we would like to provide parents with information on district procedures in the event of school closures or early dismissals due to inclement weather.

EARLY DISMISSALS

In the event that local weather conditions deteriorate rapidly during the school day, the District may be forced to dismiss early in the best interest of the safety of our children. Early dismissal notification procedures are as follows:

- *Parents receive a phone call from the automatic dialer.
- *Email notifications are also sent.
- *Notification will be posted on the district website (altonschools.org).

Please have a plan in place for your child in the event school closes early. Because winter weather is difficult to forecast, you may also pick up your child earlier than the planned dismissal time if you believe conditions will deteriorate.

In the event that the Alton School District elects to close schools for the day due to poor weather, information will be provided through the following means: local media including WBGZ Radio -1570 AM, KMOX Radio -1120 AM, KMOV Channel 4, KSDK Channel 5 and Fox 2 Now, phone call from automatic dialer, district website, Face book posting, and parent email
